

GAWDAwiki Help Tip: Editing an Entry

Imagine one afternoon you're perusing words on GAWDAwiki, and you come across the entry on "cryogenic pump." After looking over the entry, you realize there's important information missing. How do you add to the existing entry? First, make sure you're logged in by following the link in the upper right hand corner of any page in GAWDAwiki. Once you're logged in and on the page you want to edit, follow these steps:

1. Hit the "edit" tab, located at the top of each entry.
2. Type in what you want to add in the text box. Don't be intimidated by HTML symbols such as brackets and double quotes—the GAWDAwiki Editor will properly format your change.
3. Add your name and company name under "==References==" in the text box.
4. If want to see what your change will look like, hit the "show preview" button at the bottom of the page. Again, don't worry about formatting—we'll fix any errors.
5. Hit the "save page" button, also located at the bottom of the page, to submit your change.
6. If you have any questions, you can e-mail the GAWDAwiki Editor at editor@GAWDAwiki.org.
7. Within 24 hours (excluding non-business days), your change will be reviewed and edited as needed.

GAWDAwiki has over 1,200 words, so there are plenty of entries to expand on. Log in to GAWDAwiki and see what entries you find that need your knowledge.
